### **Legal Requirements:**

- Your passport should be valid for the duration of study/work in Canada, as the validity of a study/work permit cannot exceed the validity of the passport
- Biometrics for visitor visa, work/study permit
- Proof of financial support for the first year of studies in Canada
- Police clearance certificate
- Letter of acceptance from the designated learning institution
  - Must be on official letterhead, showing the exact amount of tuition fees you are required to pay, the anticipated starting and finishing dates, and the date by which you need to register
- PHOTOCOPY of the information page of your valid passport which clearly show:
  - The passport number
  - The issuance and expiry dates
  - Your photo, name, date and place of birth
- PHOTOCOPY of your marriage license/certificate (if applicable)
- PHOTOCOPY of children's birth certificates for accompanying dependents
- DIGITAL PHOTOS (one per applicant)
